-44.5%

reduction in absolute **Scope 1, 2 and 3** GHG emissions, removing 353,000 tCO₂e.

-68.9%

reduction in absolute **Scope 1 and 2** GHG emissions.

-53.2% reduction in carbon intensity. This measures emissions per unit of revenue, indicating that as we increase our delivery of food and FM services, our action levers successfully reduce our emissions.

-43.8%

absolute reduction in **scope 3** GHG emissions.

-27.0% reduction in food product emissions

-34.0% reduction in meat and fish GHG emissions

-43.2% reduction in dairy and eggs

-50.9% reduction in cleaning product emissions
